Vineyards

Sourced from the Trinidad vineyard in Maipo valley, the soils are hilly with loam and sand. The climate is mediterranean-style, with a dry summer and long maturing period.

Tasting Notes:

An intense cherry-red in color with hints of blue; complex aromas of ripe raspberries and black currant are uniquely complimented by black pepper spices, cedar and tobacco notes. Expressive and full on the palate with a balanced body and distinctively ripe, round tannins that linger on the long, chocolate finish.
