THESE SAME GEOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS PROVIDE CHILE'S FERTILE CENTRAL REGION WITH OPTIMAL CLIMATE & SOIL CONDITIONS TO PRODUCE CONSISTENT AND OUTSTANDING GRAPES EACH YEAR. THIS ROOT:1 CABERNET SAUVIGNON IS CRAFTED EXCLUSIVELY FROM GRAPES GROWN ON THE ORIGINAL, UNGRAFTED ROOT SYSTEMS TENDED BY OUR MASTER WINEMAKERS. THIS GIVES THE WINE ITS PURE, RICH FRUIT FLAVORS & AROMAS.
